

Program features

EQI study tour programs welcome groups of students from around the world to Queensland Government schools. Programs can be tailored to meet the desired learning outcomes of each study tour group and develop students' global understanding through a uniquely Australian environment.

Our metropolitan and regional schools provide access to unique learning environments where the students can enhance their English language and academic capabilities. Students will develop lifelong friendships and enhance their cultural understanding as they learn alongside their designated host school buddies in a safe and supportive environment.

Every Queensland Government school – ranging from primary, secondary, and Prep to Year 12 colleges – involved in EQI study tour programs have Accredited Officers at their school who are extensively trained to deliver a high-quality service and program. Accredited Officers develop the school program, ensuring the academic outcomes of each individual group is achieved and participants are provided with the best possible experience on their study tour.

Day visits

Half and full day visits to Queensland Government schools can be arranged for groups wishing to experience a snapshot of school life in Queensland.

Visits can include a welcome function, school orientation and integration into classes with buddies or other activities arranged by the host school.

Welcome and farewell functions

Dedicated events to officially welcome the students into the school community, and then say goodbye to their new friends and reflect on their study tour journey.

Host school buddies

Visiting students are welcomed by host school buddies. These buddies are thoughtfully selected from the school community to support and guide study tour participants throughout their program.

Classroom integration

Students will join regular classes with host school buddies and local students. Many of our schools offer excellence programs in science, leadership, sports, arts and music, making them ideal destinations for groups interested in these subjects.

English lessons

Based on the participants' English levels and desired learning outcomes, Queensland registered teachers can deliver tailored English conversational lessons to the study tour group.

Excursions

Student learning can be extended with educational and enriching activities included in the itinerary. There are many opportunities to explore Queensland's natural beauty, engage with unique Australian wildlife, and visit world famous tourist attractions. Students can also expand their knowledge in environmental sustainability and Indigenous Australian culture through visits to Environmental Education Centres.

1800QStudy

Student safety is EQI's priority. We work closely with our schools and industry partners to continuously deliver safe, high quality, and enjoyable study tour experiences for visiting students.

1800QStudy is a multi-lingual phone support service available to the study tour chaperones and EQI homestay providers after-hours, seven days a week.

The service provides advice and a process for managing and responding to incidents that involve international participants outside of school hours, ensuring student welfare and safety is always supported.

Homestay

Students from around the world can experience Australian culture by staying in a host family environment during their study tour. The accommodation, care and welfare of study tour participants is a priority for EQI and our host schools. Accredited Officers take great care in selecting families and matching them with visiting students. By living in a safe, caring and supportive home environment, students can immerse themselves in their studies, practice their English skills in a natural setting, and develop lasting friendships with their homestay family.

Specialised programs

EQI study tour programs can be tailored to meet your school's desired academic outcomes. Specialised programs are delivered by educational experts in Queensland Government schools for students with a higher level of English alongside like-minded Queensland students.

Many Queensland Government schools have been recognised for their excellence programs in areas such as science, technology, entrepreneurship, creative industry and sports. At these schools, visiting students can access contemporary learning environments and facilities which support innovation and 21st century learning.

EQI also works with industry partners including local universities, Environmental Education Centres and cultural facilities to build engaging and innovative programs. By offering flexible and specialised programs, students are able to extend their knowledge and understanding of a chosen topic.





Elite science program

Selected schools across Queensland offer innovative science programs so students can undertake advanced studies in a specific scientific field. Elite science study tours are customised to meet the specific needs of students wanting to further their scientific skills and knowledge in areas such as chemistry and biotechnology, environmental studies and agricultural sciences. Programs combine scientific research with practical activities in a variety of purpose-built and natural learning environments.

Excellence programs

Many Queensland Government schools have been identified as schools of excellence, focusing on sports, music, arts and other key curriculum areas. These schools offer innovative and specialised programs, designed and delivered by teaching professionals and experts in their chosen field. Many of these schools also have strong links with Queensland's tertiary institutes and local industry to ensure practical curriculum design and a strong foundation for students' future career development.

Global leadership program

EQI recognises the importance of empowering students and developing their leadership skills in an ever-changing global landscape. Students participating in a Global Leadership specialised study tour program will experience inspiring and challenging learning activities focused on building self-confidence, communication, teamwork and problem-solving skills. They build leadership skills that extend well beyond the study tour, forming a strong foundation for lifelong learning and global citizenship.

Virtual programs

EQIs virtual programs have been designed to take students on an educational journey. Participants have the opportunity to connect and explore with Queensland classrooms, and recognise the importance of global perspectives.

Students will have opportunities to demonstrate and develop the following skills:

- **Leadership:** identifying their own strengths and areas for growth.
- **Problem solving:** undertaking challenges and developing new skills in the process.
- **Critical thinking:** learning how to initiate and plan a project.
- **Cross-cultural communication:** recognising the benefits of working collaboratively with international partners.
- **Global awareness:** engaging with issues of global significance using a project-based approach.
- **Decision making:** recognising the impact and considering the ethics of their choices and actions.

STUDENT MASTERCLASS SERIES

Through the EQI Academy of Global Minds program, students are encouraged to actively engage with global topics. Students have the opportunity to develop their communication, investigation and collaboration skills to recognise complex differences between cultures.

Primary, junior and senior high school students are welcome to join the EQI Academy of Global Minds program. The content and difficulty of the topic streams vary, with a package available to suit every student group.

Schools can select from four topic streams to suit their learning outcomes and students' English level. Each topic stream includes access to interactive video lessons produced by EQI with Queensland education, academic and industry experts. Students are then invited to discuss their new knowledge and work through a variety of activities with Queensland Government students during virtual interactive sessions.

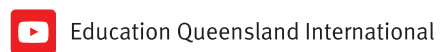
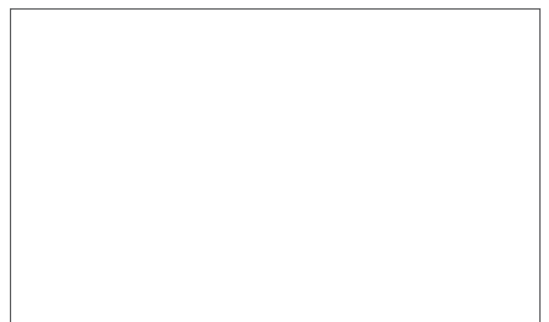
